Research scholarship

University of WA student Cameron Adams, who plans to study the relationship between positive magnetic anomalies and nickel-sulphide deposits in Kambalda, has been named a winner of the Minerals Institute of WA postgraduate research scholarships.

Mines Minister Bill Marmion will officially award the scholarships at a ceremony on April 29.

Fellow UWA student Stefano Caruso will also pick up a scholarship for his research project — mapping sulphur deposits in selected precambrian terranes of WA to enhance predictive targeting for gold and base metal mineralisation.
